### Luke 11:1-13

**Intro:** Lessons on prayer from Luke's version of the Lord's Prayer...

**v.1-2**—Learning prayer by praying...

- Prayer rooted in relationship (“Father”)...
- God's holiness, not personal happiness, is the prime purpose of prayer.  
-“Thy” over “my”...

**v.3**—“Give” reminds us we are in a role of receiver, not provider...

- God's care of daily concerns...
- “Bread” shows necessity over luxury...

### Parsing the Lord's Prayer—Part 3 (v.4)

8) \_\_\_\_\_ (v.4a)

- Confession as clearing communication (1Jn.1:8-9, Prov.28:13, Ps.32)...
- Fess ups to our mess ups...

9) \_\_\_\_\_ (v.4b)

- Our forgiveness is correlated to our forgiving (cf. Mt.6:12-15)...
- What Biblical forgiveness is and is not...
- Leaving final justice to the Judge (Ro.12:19, 2Tim.4:14-15)...

10) \_\_\_\_\_ (v.4c)

- Physical realities have spiritual roots...battle in the spiritual realm (cf. Eph.6:10-18).
- Victory over sin (cf. Rom.6:1, 6-7)...

xi) \_\_\_\_\_ (v.5-10)

- Continuous/shameless asking/seeking/knocking!

xii) \_\_\_\_\_ (v.11-13)

- God's a good Father who knows how to give good gifts!
