**What spoke to you this past Sunday (ie. what made you laugh, learn, look deeper at life etc.)?*

**In Acts 10:2, Cornelius is described as a devout and God-fearing person. Who is one person you'd describe in those terms, and what are some features of their life that lead you to label them that way?*

**The Holy Spirit strikes again in Acts 10! What have you been noticing about the work of the Holy Spirit since His initial coming in Acts 2?*

**Cornelius had called together his relatives and close friends to hear this message of God (v.24, 33). Who are some people you have a heart to share God's message with? How can we, like Cornelius, invite them to hear the message?*

**What do you notice about Peter's message to this group in v.34-44?*
